## DRUG FREE WORKPLACE & SAMHSA FIVE-PANEL DRUG SCREEN

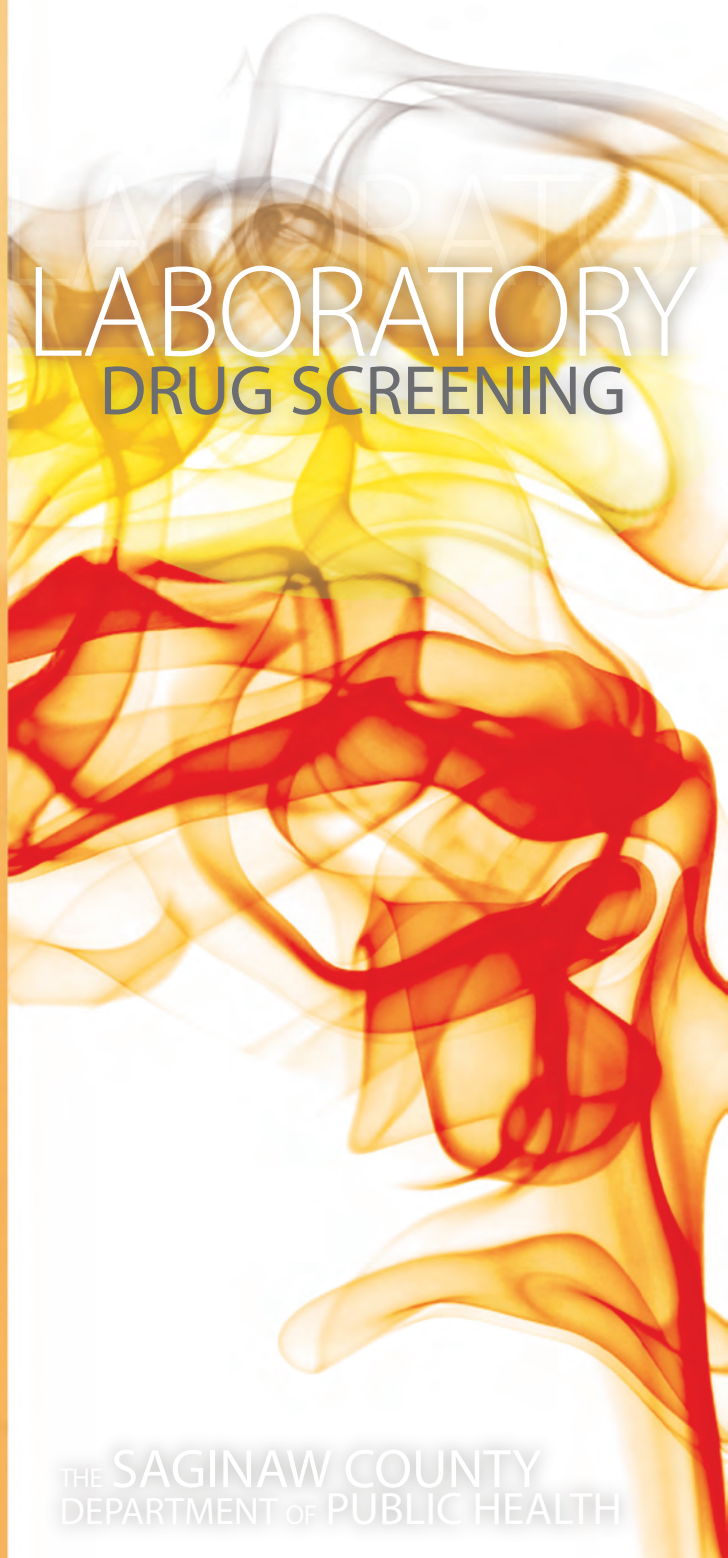

# THE LABORATORY SERVICES DIVISION

The Laboratory Services Division of Saginaw County Department of Public Health provides drug screening services to residents and non-residents of Saginaw County. No referrals necessary.

Confidential test results for drugs of abuse are accepted in over a dozen court systems in Michigan.

## CURRENT TECHNOLOGY ALLOWS THE LABORATORY TO PROVIDE:

- Zero-tolerance Program**  
 Very low sensitivity informs when drugs are present at very low levels
- Quantitative Results**  
 Positive results are reported with the quantity of drug found
- The ability to monitor usage**  
 A rise or decline in levels may reflect the client's recent drug habit
- Resistance to Adulteration**  
 Low sensitivity prevents adulteration from interfering with drug detection

DRUG NAME	TRADE/OTHER NAMES	TIME DETECTABLE	SYMPTOMS OF ABUSE
ALCOHOL	Beer, Wine, Liquor	2-14 hours	Intoxication – slurred speech, poor muscle control, drowsiness, odor of alcohol on breath
AMPHETAMINES, METHAMPHETAMINE, PHENYLPROPANOLAMINE	Biphematine, Delcobase, Obetrol, Desoxyn, Dexedrine, Black Beauties	1-2 days	Pupils dilated, dry mouth, nose, go long periods without sleeping, excess activity, irritability, argumentative, chain smoking
BARBITURATES	Amytal, Butisol, Fiorinal, Tuinal, Nembutal, Seconal, Reds, Downers, Goofballs	Varies: hours to weeks	Symptoms of alcohol abuse without odor of alcohol on breath, staggering, fall asleep unexplainably, disorientation
BENZODIAZEPINES	Ativan, Dalmane, Librium, Restoril, Serax, Valium, Tranxene, Versed, Halcion, Paxipam, Xanax	3 days (therapeutic) 4-6 wks after extended use	Symptoms of alcohol abuse without odor of alcohol on breath, staggering, fall asleep unexplainably, disorientation
CANNABINOID	THC, Marinol, Pot, Grass, Acapulco Gold, Reefer, Sinsemilla, Thai Sticks	Occasional use: 1-7 days Chronic use: 1-10 weeks	Rapid, loud talking, stupor, pupils may be dilated, burnt rope smell on clothing or breath
COCAINE METABOLITE	Coke, Flake, Snow, Crack	2-4 days	Pupils dilated, dry mouth, nose, go long periods without sleeping, excess activity, irritability, argumentative, chain smoking
METHADONE	Dolophine, Methadone	1-3 days	Drowsiness, "pinpoint pupils", injection scars, syringes, bent spoons, eyedroppers, cotton or needles may be found
OPIATES: CODEINE, MORPHINE, HEROIN	Roxanol, Tylenol w/codeine, Robitussin AC, Horse, Fiorinal w/codeine, Smack, Diacetylmorphine, Dragons Tail	1-2 days	Drowsiness, "pinpoint pupils", redness or rawness around nostrils if inhaled, injection scars, syringes, bent spoons, eyedroppers, cotton or needles may be found
PHENCYCLIDINE	PCP, Angel Dust, Hog	Occasional use: 1-8 days Chronic use: up to 30 days	Very abnormal behavior, can have depressant effects or cause bizarre or violent responses
