

Post Vaccine Quarantine Guidance

The CDC says you do <u>not</u> have to quarantine for 10-14 days after exposure to someone with COVID-19 if:







It's been

at least two weeks
since your final COVID-19

vaccine dose,

It's been **Within three**months or 90 days of your final COVID-19 dose,

And you are **Showing**no symptoms.

While the CDC waits for further data on how vaccination prevent transmission, they are choosing three months because it aligns with guidance on quarantine for people who have been naturally infected with COVID-19.

This guidance may change.
