“Lock-It Up” Campaign Launches to Educate Residents About Medical Marijuana Safety

(SAGINAW) – The Saginaw County Health Department is launching the “Lock-It Up” Campaign, thanks to a grant from the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). Medical marijuana is a public health concern, especially as it relates to protecting children and youth. Our multi-media educational effort will inform county residents on the safest use, storage, and handling of medical marijuana to protect everyone.

As part of the grant-funded campaign, we will be distributing 1,000 lockboxes for safe storage and handling, along with educational materials to ensure medical marijuana stays out of the hands of children. The lockboxes are free and can be picked up at the Saginaw County Health Department building at 1600 N. Michigan Avenue. Due to COVID-19 building entry restrictions, appointments are required.
